In having a cumulative grade point average of less than 2.75 or 54 percentage in British grade point average, candidates must pass the fundamental complementary alternative medicine comprehensive exam or have academic achievements at least one relevant academic publication.</p> <p>2. Applicants who do not meet the qualifications in clauses 1. shall be at their discretion and approved by the Graduate Program Executive Committee. In the case of foreign students who speak English as the primary language, they must meet the criteria specified in items 1 and 2 of the RMUTT Announcement on Graduate School English Language Proficiency Criteria (No.2). AD. 2016 and in case of receiving a scholarship, the scholarship fund must meet the selection criteria and submit the</p>
